Designed by Dunedin for Dunedin, DunedinNZ Insights and the Dunedin Key Visitor Statistics dashboards together with other Dunedin data and information can be found on the [‘Research & statistics’](#) page of the DunedinNZ.com website.

These interactive dashboards are useful tools for all: local government and businesses, tourism operators, visitors, students and their families and the wider Dunedin community.

They are designed to help you take advantage of opportunities by identifying trends, keeping ahead of change and informing marketing and management activities for Dunedin as a compelling and great year-round destination.

Make the dashboards the first point of call when looking for Dunedin-specific data and use the links for a deeper dive to the source reports and surveys:

- 1. Get a high-level view:** A summary sheet lets you see the key indicators for each data set in the report. This gives you the ability to quickly review the current status and have a good high-level view of what is happening.
- 2. Get more detailed information:** If you want more information on a specific topic you can jump to that sheet to get into the data at a deeper level.
- 3. Go to the source:** Additional information to links for a deeper dive to source reports and surveys.

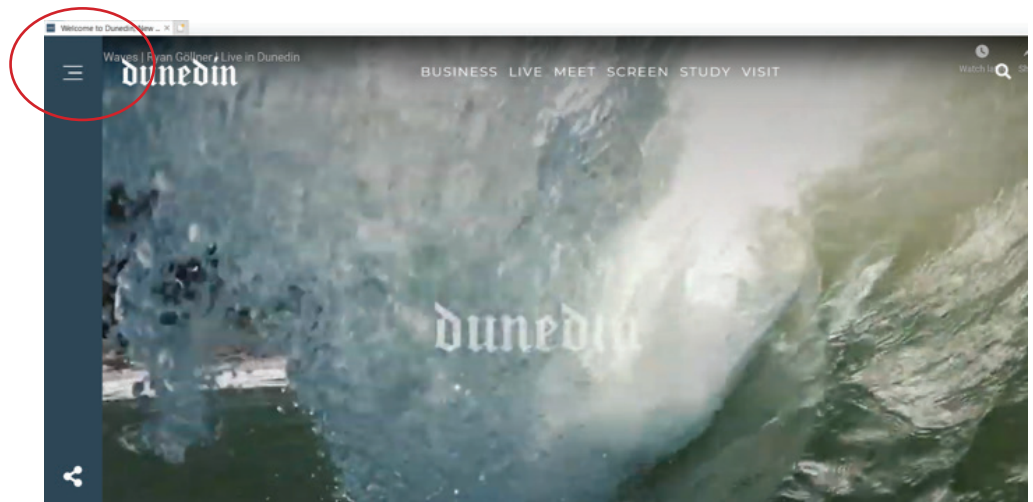
The following provides a practical, step-by-step guide to help you find your way round the dashboards to get the information you need.

Accessing the dashboards

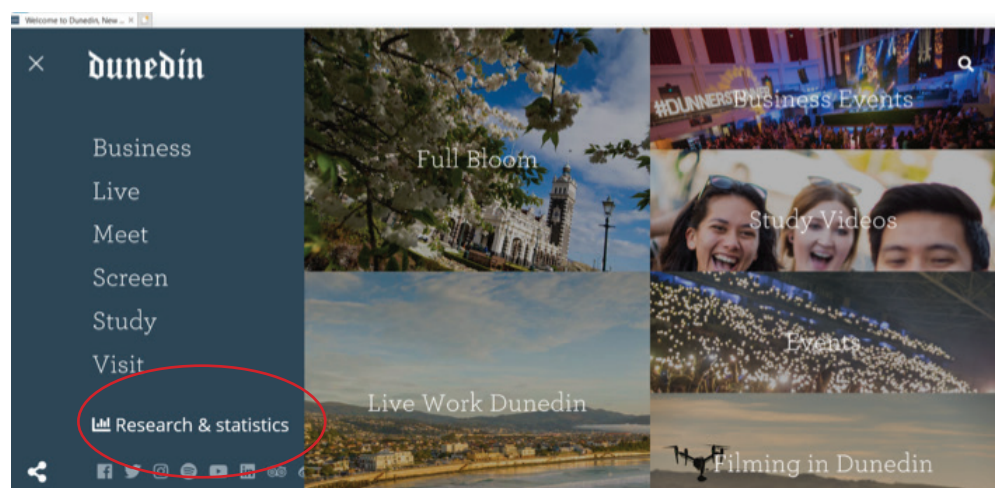

- There are FIVE ways to access the 'Research & statistics' page, once there click on each of the tile images to access the dashboard you want to view, move between dashboards by clicking the ☺ on the top left-hand corner of your screen or by clicking on the links in the 'In this section' menu on the left-hand side of the 'Dunedin city economic monitor' and 'Help navigating our dashboards' homepages to go directly to the dashboard you want to view:

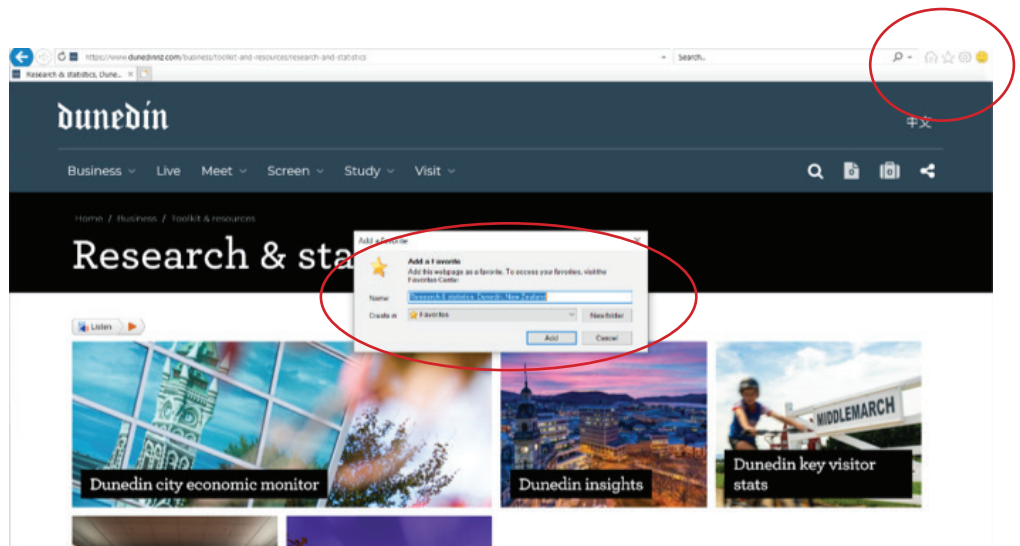

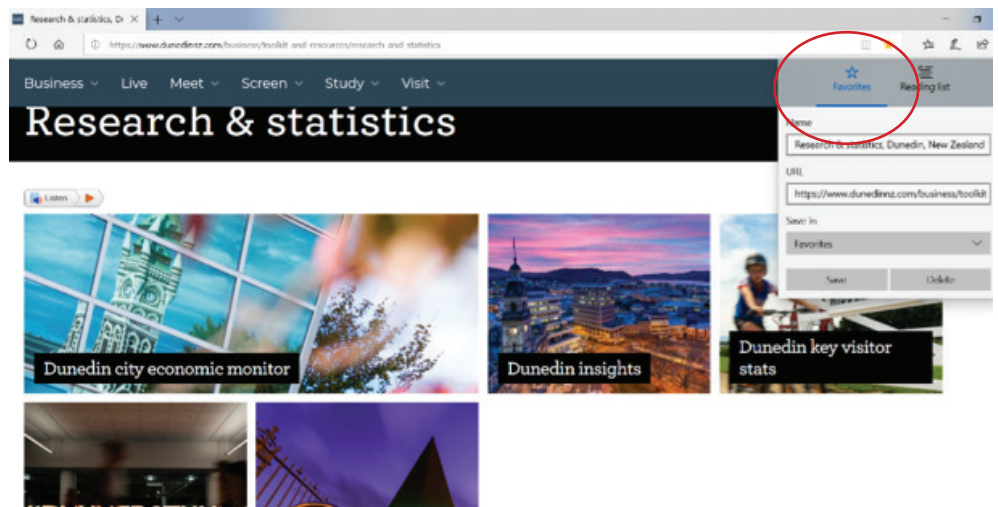
5. Save the DunedinNZ.com website and/or 'Research & statistics' page(s) as a favourite(s)

Printing

1. In full:

If you would like to print the current dashboards in full, you can print a downloadable PDF for each dashboard from the 'Help navigating our dashboards' page on the 'Research & statistics' homepage.

2. By page:

- The dashboards are designed primarily as interactive tools. However, depending on your web browser and system setup, you can print pages from the dashboards by following these steps:
 - Right click on mouse
 - From the dropdown list displayed, click on Print Preview
 - At the top of Print Preview, click paper orientation icon to 'Landscape'
 - At the top of Print Preview, set 'Shrink to fit' to 85%
 - Click on Print  icon
 - Click on Pages – and enter required page number(s) as directed
 - Click Print

- You can also make the dashboards full screen, by clicking on this icon  on the bottom right hand side of the screen then use a snipping tool (eg Microsoft 'Snip & Sketch').

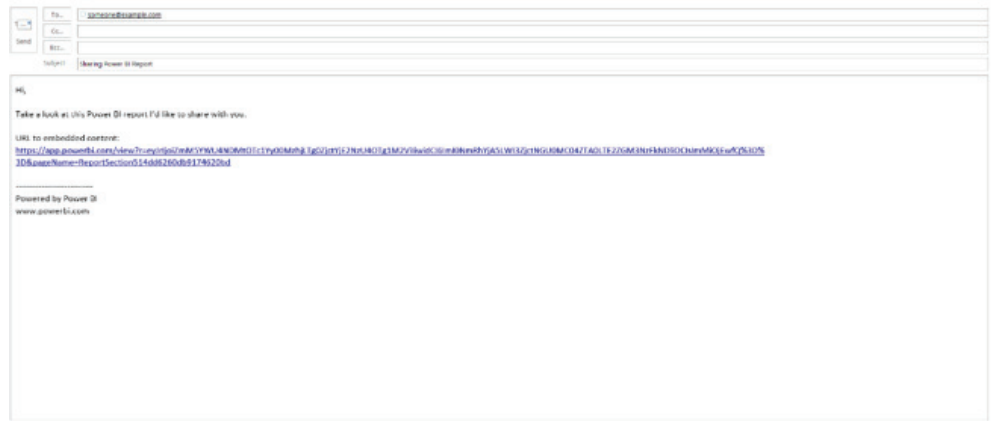
Sharing the dashboards by email

1. Use the email template

A generic Power BI template is generated when clicking on this icon  on the bottom right hand side of the screen:



- Delete 'someone@example.com' and type in the email address you want to send the information to.
- You may also like to customise the subject 'Sharing Power BI Report' and the email wording.

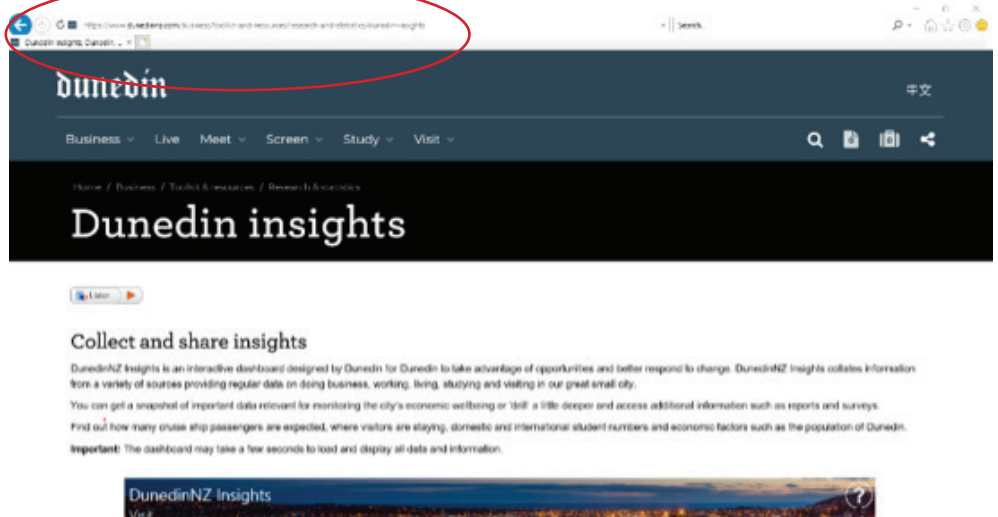

2. Copy and paste the page URL into your email

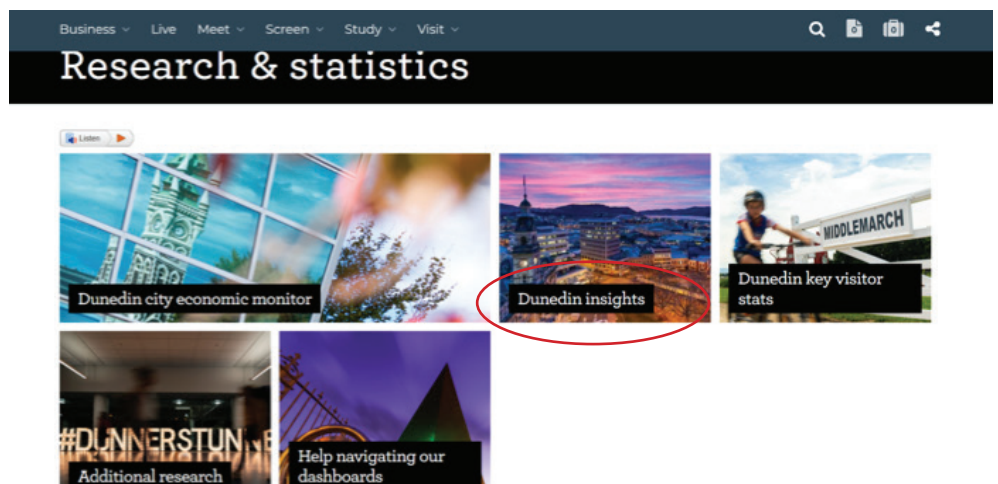
Simply copy and paste the URL for the page you would like to share into your email or document.

Fully automated and interactive DunedinNZ Insights collates data and information from a variety of sources, providing regular data on investing, working, living, studying and visiting in our great small city.

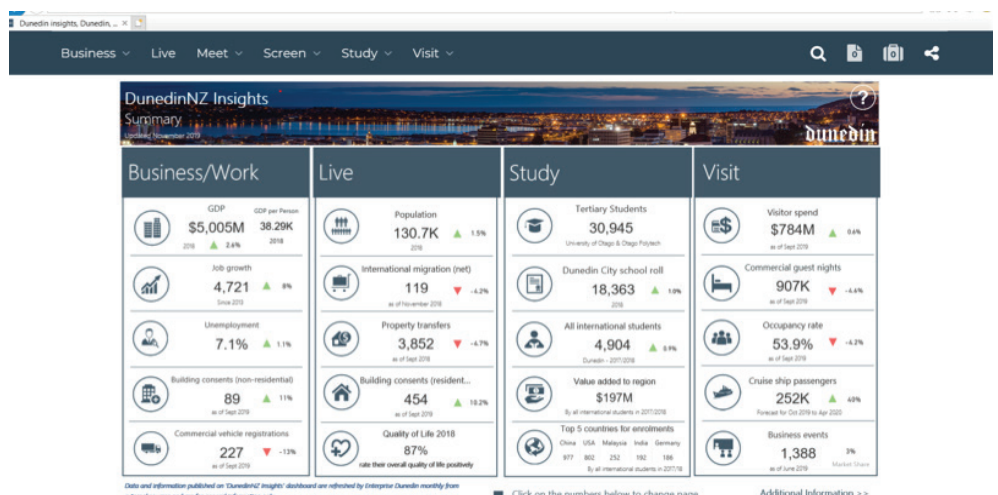
You can get a snapshot of important and topical data relevant for monitoring the city's economic wellbeing such as job growth, school student numbers, house sales and building consents.

Through links to detailed reports and surveys, you can also 'drill' deeper for additional information if you need to. Separate pages also list the data sources and provide a helpful glossary.

Find out how many cruise ship passengers are expected, where visitors stay, domestic and international student numbers and economic details such as Dunedin's population as well as statistics and trends across a number of different areas.

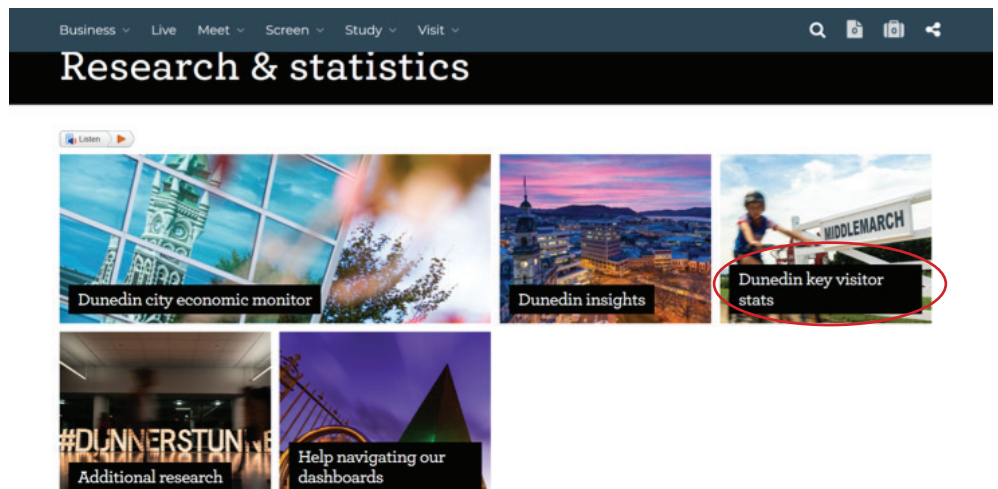

Dunedin Key Visitor Statistics

- From the Research & statistics homepage, click on 'Dunedin key visitor stats':



This dashboard provides top line, high-level key visitor statistics on domestic and international visitor and product spend, country of origin, guest nights and accommodation type, average length of stay and occupancy rate.

Use the interactive graphs and tables to find out more about **international visitor spend, visitor product spend, commercial guest nights, occupancy rate and guest arrivals** and **regional comparisons**.

A separate page also lists the data sources and provides a helpful glossary.
